What goes in my Green Cart?

All Food Waste

- Breads
- Fruit & vegetable scraps
- Meat, bones, fish & shellfish including shells
- · Dairy products, eggshells
- · Nuts & shells, candies
- Coffee filters & grounds, tea bags
- Grease & fat

Food Soiled Paper Products

- Soiled paper towels & napkins
- Used paper plates
- Paper flour & sugar bags
- Pizza boxes
- Parchment paper

Yard Waste

- Leaves
- Weeds
- Twigs & branches less than 2" in diameter & 4' in length

Place yard waste directly in your cart. Make sure there are no branches sticking out of your cart & the lid can close.

Compostable bags must have one of these symbols:







RECYCLING

Sort your recyclables into 3 categories.

1. Corrugated Cardboard Flatten boxes

All cardboard boxes with the wavy piece in the middle

2. Paper & Boxboard

- Newspaper & flyers
- Office paper & envelopes
- Catalogues, phone books
- Magazines, brochures & glossy paper
- · Hard & soft cover books
- Cereal, cracker & tissue boxes
- Egg cartons

3. Plastic Metal & Milk

Rinse all containers thoroughly

Plastic Containers (1) (2) (5)



- Milk, juice jugs
- Yogurt, sour cream, cream cheese & ice cream tubs
- Ketchup, & salad dressing bottles
- Shampoo bottles
- Bleach & detergent bottles
- Beverage containers (no glass)

Milk Cartons

• Milk, cream & buttermilk cartons

Metal Containers

- All food & pet food cans
- Aluminum pie plates & foil
- Pop cans



GARBAGE

All garbage goes in your own bags or containers

- Plastic Bags & plastic wrap
- Plastics with no recycling codes
- Diapers & sanitary hygiene products
- Coffee cups & lids
- Styrofoam
- Chip & cookie bags
- Granola & chocolate bar wrappers
- Butter wrappers
- Gift wrap
- Dryer sheets & lint
- Cotton balls & swabs
- Bottle caps & lids



HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

HHW accepted at Crane Mountain Landfill year round, 6 days a week.

Typical HHW items:

Batteries (household/car), bleach, cleaning products, CFL bulbs, driveway sealant, fertilizers, insecticides paints and thinners, pool chemicals, propane tanks, Electronics (TV's computers & more), tires.

RECYCLING

GARBAGE

- Line your kitchen bin with a sheet of newspaper to absorb moisture
- Empty and rinse bin regularly
- Layer yard waste between kitchen scraps to combat odours.
- Additional yard waste can be put in paper leaf & yard waste bags.

DO NOT INCLUDE:

- **x** Ashes
- x Coffee cups
- x Plastic bags
- x Cigarette butts
- x Wax paper
- x Styrofoam
- x Tree stumps
- x Rocks & gravel
- **x** Bricks
- x Branches larger than 2" in diameter

Compostable bags must have one of these symbols:

- Visit FundyRecycles.com and search for items in 'What Goes Where?'
- Flatten cardboard boxes
- Remove all caps from containers
- Rinse containers thoroughly
- Look for recycling symbols 1, 2 or 5 (1) (2) (5)



DO NOT INCLUDE:

- x Plastic bags, including grocery bags, bread bags & plastic wrap
- x Black garbage bags
- x Wet or dirty cardboard
- x Coffee cups or lids
- x Waxed cardboard or paper
- x Vinyl siding
- x Styrofoam
- x Chip bags
- x Plastic furniture or toys

- Never mix materials
