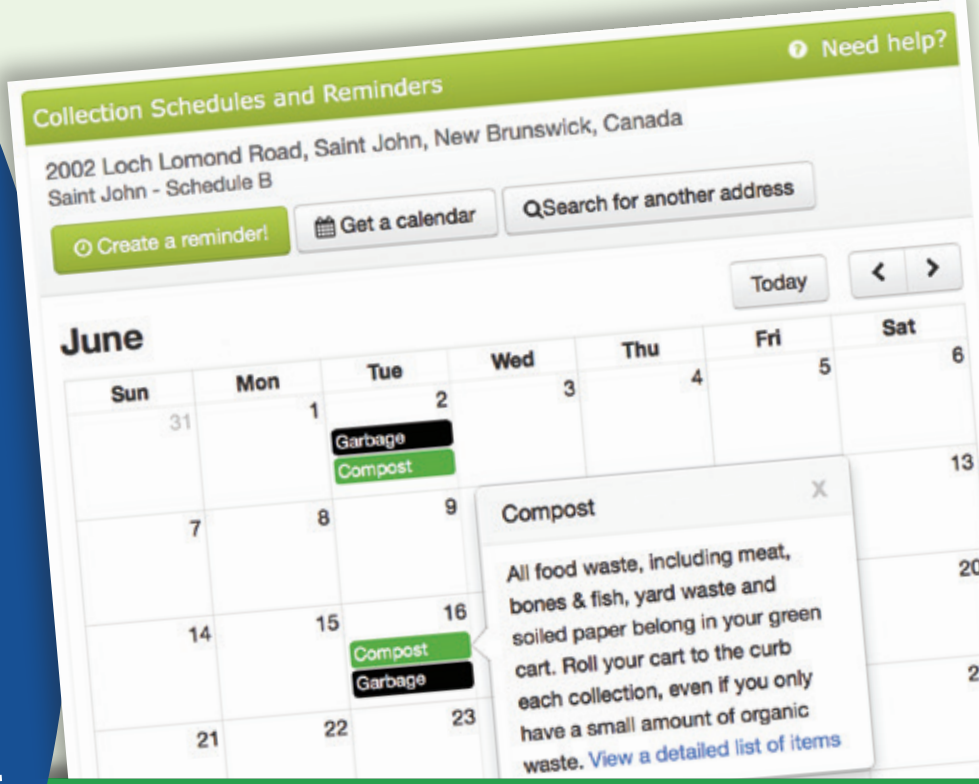

COMPOST



Sort all your food and yard waste into your green compost cart.

WHAT TO COMPOST

All Food Waste

- Breads
- Fruits & vegetables
- Meat, bones, fish & shellfish including shells
- Cooking oil, grease & fat

Yard Waste

- Brush, leaves, weeds, grass clippings, twigs & branches (less than 2" in diameter).

Other Material

- Paper napkins & paper towels, paper plates, pizza boxes
- Clay based kitty litter, pet waste

HOW TO PREPARE

Collect food in your kitchen bin. Line your bin with newspaper, compostable or brown paper bags; empty & rinse regularly.

Place yard waste directly in your cart. Wrap kitty litter & pet waste in newspaper, paper or compostable bag.

Compostable bags must have one of these symbols:



DO NOT INCLUDE

- ✗ Ashes
- ✗ Milk cartons
- ✗ Plastic bags
- ✗ Coffee cups
- ✗ Cigarette butts
- ✗ Styrofoam
- ✗ Tree stumps
- ✗ Rocks & gravel
- ✗ Bricks

RECYCLING

Sort your recyclables and bring to the blue recycling bins.

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD



Corrugated cardboard has the wavy piece in the middle. Please flatten.

- Packaging boxes
- Appliance boxes

Boxboard (tissue, cereal boxes, etc.) belongs in the Paper & Boxboard bin.

✗ **Never** use black or coloured garbage bags to collect recycling. It will be viewed as garbage.

PAPER & BOXBOARD



Please flatten boxboard. Clean & dry paper.

Paper

- Newspaper
- Office paper
- Catalogues, phone books
- Magazines, flyers, brochures & glossy paper
- Hard & soft cover books

Boxboard

- Cereal & cracker boxes
- Tissue boxes
- Egg cartons
- Toilet paper & paper towel cores

PLASTIC, METAL & MILK



All in the same bin!

Plastic Containers

Rinse containers thoroughly. Remove caps.

Look for the recycling symbol with 1, 2, or 5.



- Milk, juice jugs
- Yogurt containers, sour cream, cottage cheese tubs
- Ice cream tubs
- Ketchup, oil, vinegar & salad dressing bottles
- Peanut butter containers
- Shampoo bottles
- Bleach & detergent bottles
- Beverage containers (no glass)

Plastic Bags

Stuff bags into one bag

- Bubble wrap
- Shopping bags, bread bags, milk bags, resealable food & freezer bags

Milk Cartons

- Milk, cream & buttermilk cartons

Metal Containers

- All food & pet food cans
- Aluminum pie plates
- Clean aluminum foil
- Pop cans

DO NOT INCLUDE

- ✗ Wet or dirty cardboard, e.g. pizza boxes
- ✗ Milk cartons
- ✗ Coffee cups
- ✗ Waxed cardboard

DO NOT INCLUDE

- ✗ Gift wrap
- ✗ Wax paper
- ✗ Coffee cups
- ✗ Donut boxes
- ✗ Milk cartons

DO NOT INCLUDE

- ✗ Vinyl siding
- ✗ Styrofoam
- ✗ Black garbage bags
- ✗ Chocolate bar wrappers
- ✗ Chip bags
- ✗ Aerosol cans
- ✗ Paint cans

ACCEPTABLE HHW

Save up your Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) and bring it to Crane Mountain Landfill.



Computer systems – monitor, CPU, mouse, keyboard, speakers & printers (Recycling Fee \$5/system).

Common HHW products

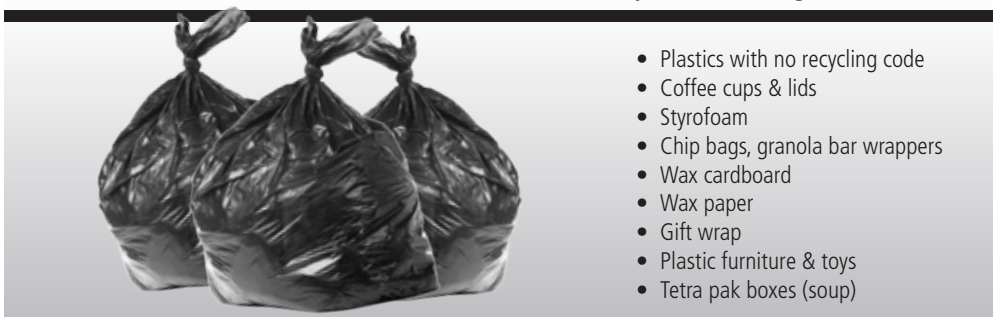
No Charge Drop Off

- Batteries
- Compact fluorescent light bulbs
- Fluorescent light tubes
- Paints, stains, varnishes & thinners
- Used motor oil & filters
- Gasoline, kerosene, diesel fuel, ethanol
- Antifreeze, transmission fluid
- Propane tanks & cylinders
- Driveway sealant
- Pesticides, herbicides & insecticides

Household Hazardous Waste accepted Monday to Saturday, regular landfill hours.

GARBAGE

All garbage goes in your own bags or containers.



- Plastics with no recycling code
- Coffee cups & lids
- Styrofoam
- Chip bags, granola bar wrappers
- Wax cardboard
- Wax paper
- Gift wrap
- Plastic furniture & toys
- Tetra pak boxes (soup)

You can always bring your items to Crane Mountain Landfill

Monday to Friday: 7:30 am to 5:00 pm

Saturday: 8:00 am to 12:00 noon

Closed: Christmas and New Year's Day
